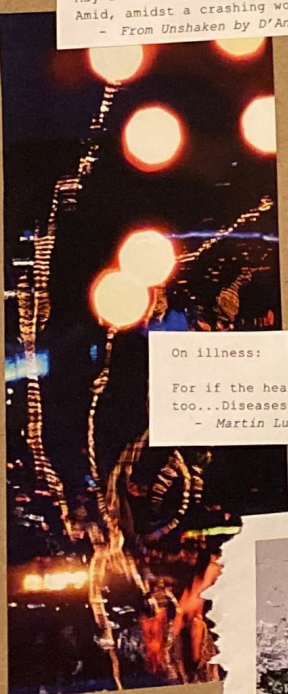


On the game:

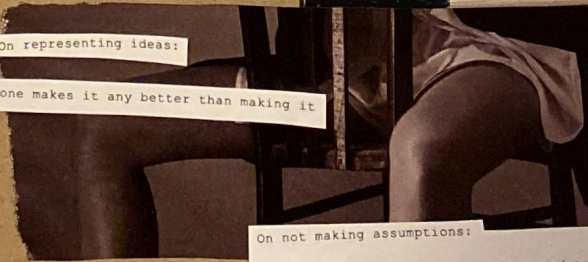
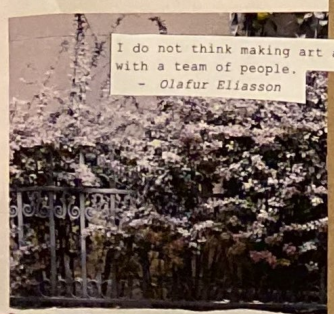
